

Uniform Cleaning Instructions



1. Remove sequined lapel (VERY IMPORTANT!). Do not wash.
2. Separate bibs and jackets.
3. Divide bibs in to 2-3 loads. You should only wash 4 or 5 bibs at a time. They need to be able to move pretty freely in the washer for the best cleaning results.
4. Divide jackets into 2-3 loads. You should only wash 4 or 5 jackets at a time, and 5 might be too many if your washer is on the small side. They also need a lot of room to get their cleanest.
5. Use only COLD water and the detergent provided. Do not add softener.
6. You may hang to dry or toss in the dryer using COOL air only. Any heat will possibly cause shrinkage, and a few of the uniforms fit snugly already.
7. When returning the uniforms to their hangers, pay close attention to the labels in the uniforms and the label on the hanger. The numbers should match. If the numbers don't match, please make a note of it and let me know.

*If the numbers don't match, it is possible the jackets or bibs accidentally got switched when the students were changing clothes.

8. Once everything is clean and dry, reattach the sequined lapels. The number on the back of the lapel should match the number on the jacket. Once again, if the numbers don't match, make a note of it and let me know. Finally, correctly hang the bib and jacket back on the hanger. Ask your student if you need help.
